relic |'relik| noun an object surviving from an earlier time, esp. one of historical or sentimental interest.

• a part of a deceased holy person's body or belongings kept as an object of reverence.

• an object, custom, or belief that has survived from an earlier time but is now outmoded : individualized computer programming and timesharing would become expensive relics.

• (relics) all that is left of something : relics of a lost civilization.
